Deployment

Requirements

The recommended deployment method for Seafile Server Professional Edition is via Docker. It can also be installed directly on Linux. The recommended operating systems are Debian/Ubuntu.

The minimum requirements are 4 cores and 8GB RAM. Seafile Server Professional Edition requires roughly 10GB of disk space including prerequisites and third-party components. With larger user numbers, more cores and RAM may be needed depending on the usage patterns.

For high-availability setups, Seafile Server Professional Edition supports clustering and object storage.



Licensing

Seafile Server Professional Edition can be used without a paid license file with up to three users for trialing purposes.

Seafile Server requires a paid license for use with more than 3 users. You can purchase a license for Seafile Server Professional Edition in KooGallery. For a custom quote, please contact datamate GmbH & Co. KG for a quote.

The license file must be available on the Seafile Server when starting the Seafile service. A new license file (e.g. after a license extension of upgrade) can also be applied via the system administration in Seafile's web interface:



If the license file is not valid or the number of licensed users is less than the number of active registered users, the Seafile service will refuse to start.

The <u>Seafile EULA</u> applies for paid licenses as well as when using Seafile.
